Arrived at Roadford Reservoir and stopped to look at the massive lake and the sailing boats.

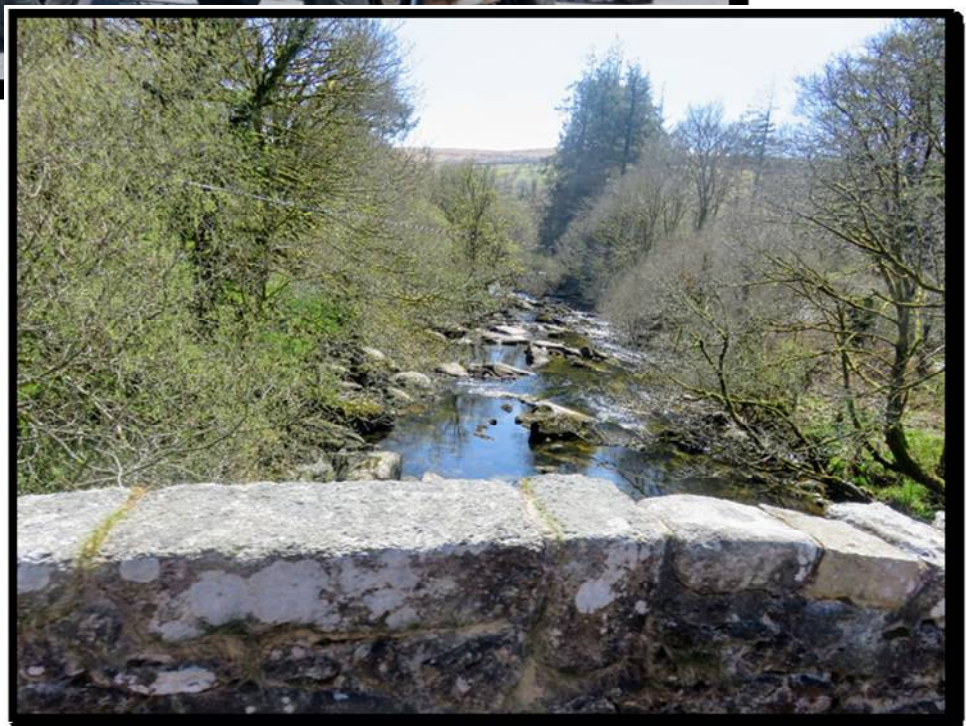


Luckily the café was open for take a way, so most of the group had a coffee while relaxing by the lake.

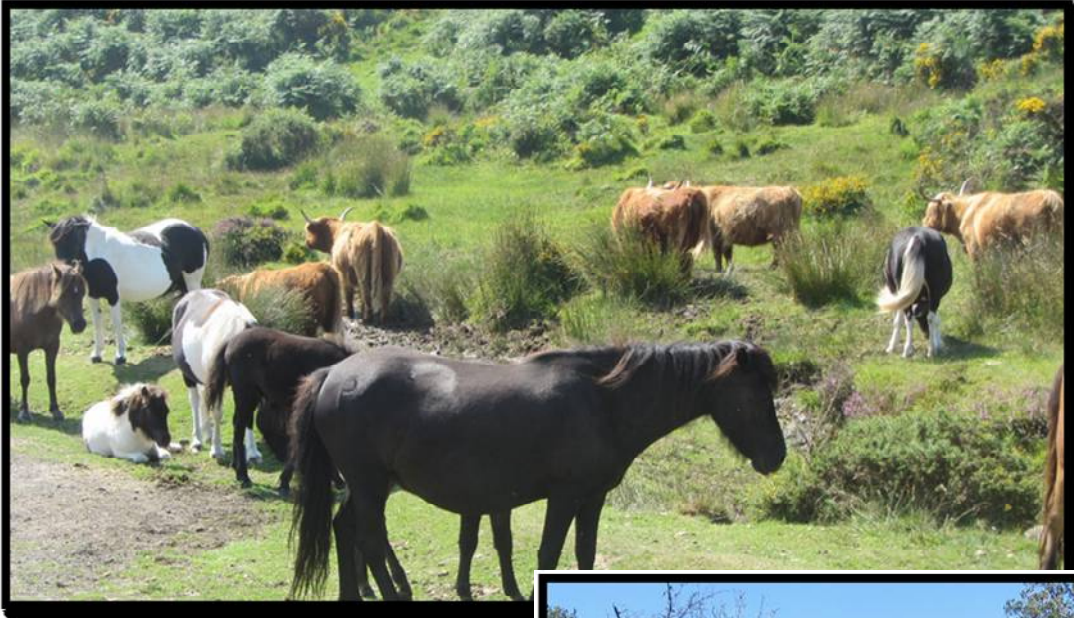
